## The Eliminate Project

### Project Purpose

To reduce the incidence of child and maternal mortality in **Chad, Kenya, Pakistan, South Sudan, and Sudan** through maternal and neonatal tetanus elimination (MNTE).

### Designed to Achieve

To vaccinate 3.4 million women of reproductive age (WRA), train nearly 13,000 health care workers on clean delivery, routine immunization and antenatal care.
