Project Purpose

To reduce the incidence of child and maternal mortality in Chad, Kenya, Pakistan, South Sudan, and Sudan through maternal and neonatal tetanus elimination (MNTE).

Designed to Achieve

To vaccinate 3.4 million women of reproductive age (WRA), train nearly 13,000 health care workers on clean delivery, routine immunization and antenatal care.
