Strengthening Health Outcomes for Women and Children (SHOW)



Project Purpose

Reduction of maternal and child mortality amongst vulnerable women and children, including adolescent girls, in targeted remote, underserved regions of Bangladesh, Ghana, Haiti, Nigeria and Senegal.

Designed to Achieve

The quality, availability, utilization and accountability of essential maternal, newborn and child health (MNCH) and sexual and reproductive health (SRH) services will be improved in the 5 countries.

Midterm Results



Post-partum use of **contraception** has increased in **four out of five countries.**

Increase in **women** attending post-natal care within 48 hours of the birth.

Average increase of births attended by a **Skilled Birth Attendant** in project areas.



15%
Increase in **pregnant women** attending antenatal care at least four times.
