## **Project Purpose**

The reduction of maternal and child mortality in targeted regions.



## **Designed to Achieve**

Improved nutrition in women of reproductive age (15-49) and children under 5 years in **Malawi, Mozambique** and **Zambia**.



60,726

Households participated in Care Group meetings and received visits from CHWs.



% of men and women using improved drinking water sources

48% Zambia (150% of project target); 92% Malawi (108% of project target); 66% Mozambique (150% of project target).



% of children exclusively breastfed

85% **Zambia** (110% of project target); 86% **Malawi** (115% of project target); 82% **Mozambique** (114% of project target).
