WHY YOU'LL LOVE IT

- Search by **areas of focus** to see who is working where and on what issues to identify gaps within your communities of interest.
- Search by **funder** to see who funds similar projects so that you can approach them with appropriate and targeted asks.
- Search projects in specific communities and click on “partner and funder profiles” to discover **local organizations** that you might not otherwise find.
- Search by sector topic to identify **target populations** in order to see who is being reached (or not) to help select your priority focus groups.
- Search project-specific **outputs** to see what approaches have been successful and connect with lead organizations to learn about their work.

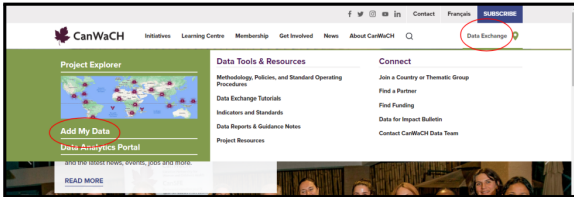
Step 1: Check out what the Project Explorer has to offer [here](#)

Step 2: Add your data to the Project Explorer

- ✓ Save your completed project form as a draft for review by CanWaCH admin.

1. Hover over **Data Exchange** and click **Add My Data** from the dropdown menu.

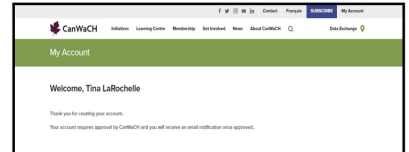


Check your email

Once your new account is created, you will receive an email confirmation.



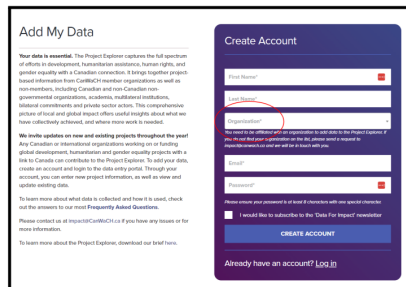
Clicking the link in the email confirmation directs you to a login page. After you log in, you will be directed to your Account page which will display the following message:
