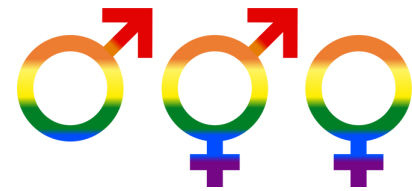

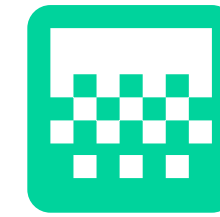

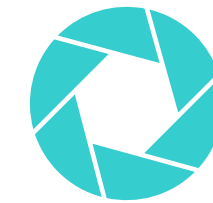

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Needs Assessment



- **PROMPT:** Generate a summary of key challenges and gaps in gender-transformative health programming based on the literature and global health reports related to our program.
- **PROMPT:** Create a concise list of the emerging priorities for gender-inclusive health interventions, particularly for women and girls in area (X). Summarize research findings and expert opinions. Include sources for the information you provide.

*remember internet search depends on ChatGPT version

Stakeholder Engagement



- **PROMPT:** Generate scripts for engaging community leaders (both women and men) and local NGOs in our gender-transformative health program focused, ensuring inclusivity and cultural sensitivity.
- **PROMPT:** Create a list of 15 talking points for an upcoming community meeting on gender-inclusive health policies, addressing concerns and building support from diverse stakeholders.

Theory of Change



- **PROMPT:** Articulate a comprehensive theory of change for our gender-transformative health program, outlining the logic behind each intended outcome and the pathways for change.
- **PROMPT:** Review my Theory of Change and provide clear feedback on how to refine it based on Global Affairs Canada's Guidance here. Provide tips and suggested changes to ensure alignment with gender-transformative programming principles.

Indicators



- **PROMPT:** Design indicators (based on Global Affairs Canada's Results Based Management approach) for each of my program outcomes here that specifically measure the impact of our gender-transformative health program (include one qualitative indicator and one quantitative).
- **PROMPT:** Recommend 5 performance indicators for tracking progress in reducing gender disparities in access to sexual and reproductive healthcare services within these specific populations, based on industry standards.

Challenges & Risks



- **PROMPT:** Identify potential gender-specific challenges and risks associated with implementing our health program considering cultural, social, and political factors and propose concise strategies to mitigate them.
- **PROMPT:** Assess the potential impact of our proposed health intervention on vulnerable populations, particularly transgender individuals and women in marginalized communities. Suggest strategies to address their specific needs.
